Thank you for contacting Transport for Wales. In response to your letter concerning 'vaccine passports' dated 8 December 2020, we can confirm that Transport for Wales will not be implementing such a scheme. As Transport for Wales is subject to Welsh Government regulation; and as the COVID-19 vaccination is not mandatory; unless receiving the vaccine and the requirement to carry a vaccine passport was made law (together with powers of enforcement), this will not be considered. The Rail Delivery Group (RDG) have also taken this same position.

Though the COVID-19 vaccination will protect the individual receiving it, Transport for Wales has a responsibility to protect all customers and staff, and will continue to promote and maintain our protective measures such as enhanced cleaning, social distancing, and mandatory face-covering requirements. These preventative measures provide an essential line of protection to all those using our services safely, whilst we continue to follow Government, industry and health-specialist advice.
