Additionally if you have this information could you also advise of the following:

How many Drivers do you currently employ and out of them how many are Welsh speakers?

How many Guards do you currently employ and out of them how many are Welsh speakers?

How many Revenue Protection Inspectors do you currently employ and out of them how many are Welsh speakers?

How many Ticket Office Clerks do you currently employ and out of them how many are Welsh speakers?" [Part B]

Having reviewed your questions, we are able to provide the following information:

TfW Core and TfW Innovation

In reference to <u>Part A</u> of your request: As a result of staffing changes within the HR department, unfortunately we have been unable to collect this information and update our system within the timescales originally planned. This is still within our plans to complete, and we are now aiming complete this exercise by mid-2022. <u>Part B</u> of your request is not applicable to TfW Core and TfW Innovation.

TfW Rail Limited

In reference to <u>Part A and B</u> of your request: This information is not currently held. However, a system for collecting and collating this data is in development, whilst a reminder will be circulated shortly asking all employees to volunteer this information using the existing employee self-service portal. Going forward, this information will also be collected at point of first employment.
