We are writing in response to your Freedom of Information request. Your request has been considered in accordance with the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act and our Data and Information Management Policy.

"I would like to have details of the numbers of passengers using Bow Street railway station (just North of Aberystwyth). Following its opening two months worth of users was published. I would like the number of current and past users on a monthly basis over the last year."

Having reviewed your questions, we are able to provide the following information:

Please find below the passenger numbers for Bow Street Station since its reopening in February 2021. It is important that these are indicative figures <u>only</u>, as the Office of Rail and Road (ORR) publish annual station usage estimates on their website annually and these figures will be the agreed final number.
