

# Llanrwst



Distance: 3.3km / 2 miles  
Difficulty: easy  
Walking time: 1.5 hours

This route follows paths through the town then along the river Conwy. A playground is available near the end of the route.

On leaving Llanrwst station turn left heading into the town centre. When you reach the clock tower head right and follow the road as it bends round to the right by Snowdonia Antiques.

Follow this road past the library until you see Station road turning off to the left. Follow this road down to Llanrwst North Station. Just before the station turn left passing a small industrial estate and cross the river Conwy on Pont Gower Bridge.

Immediately after the bridge take the stile on the left leading you into the field. Follow the clear path until another stile takes you left. A number of stiles then lead you across fields onto a track. Please be aware that this area does flood so after heavy rain can be very wet.

At the track turn left and follow until you meet the road. Crossing over you will find a small playground but otherwise to continue the route turn left at the road and with caution cross the bridge. After crossing the bridge turn left and follow the road back into the town centre and to the clock tower. A right turn here will take you back to the station.

Routes can be affected by path closures, blockages and diversions. If you find yourself unable to continue with your walk please try to find an alternate route or retrace your steps. Report any issues to your local authority.
