Core Valley Lines (CVL) Network Statement 2026 – Industry Consultation

Under Regulation 13 of The Railways (Access, Management and Licensing of Railway Undertakings) Regulations 2016 (as amended), Seilwaith Amey Cymru / Amey Infrastructure Wales Ltd (“AIW”), as the Infrastructure Manager of the Core Valley Lines (“CVL”) Network is required (following consultation with all interested parties) to develop and publish a Network Statement containing certain information relating to the CVL. Accordingly, please find attached our draft Network Statement 2026 for consultation. This consultation process will run from 20 August 2024 until 20 September 2024.
